Position Description

Responsibilities:

- Maintain an open line of communication with shelter staff. Alert staff immediately of unusual behavior or medical problems you observe in the animals you have contact with. Abide by all shelter rules, respect the staff and clients and most importantly, be kind and attentive to the animals while you are working at the shelter.

Requirements:

- Ability and desire to handle and work with kennel animals
- Willingness to maintain sanitation of animal areas
- Ability to work independently
- Good communication skills
- Dedication to the philosophies of the Valley Humane League
- Ability to lift up to 50 pounds
- Minimum of 16 years of age, unless accompanied by an adult
- Ability to wear appropriate uniform: long pants and closed toed shoes at all times, treat bags (optional but highly recommended)
